Intramurals:

Giving Mayfield students in 5th and 6th grade an opportunity to play and learn team sports with the emphasis on school work and attitude (reward).

Positive Behavior:

(A) School Work:

1. Player must be putting their best effort in completing all assignments to participate.
2. Player must have at least a 1.5 GPA to continue to play intramurals (same as high school eligibility).
3. Player will sit out if not completing their assignments.
4. Removed from that intramural sport if player has to sit out 3 times for missed assignments.

(B) Behavior (Discipline Referrals):

1. Reward to play intramurals at Mayfield.
2. 3 Strike Rule:
 - a. A player will be suspended one game for the first Minor Infraction (Strike 1).
 - b. A player will be suspended again from that intramural sport for the 2nd Minor Infraction (Strike 2).
 - c. A player will be removed from intramurals for the 3rd Minor Infraction or the 1st Major Infraction (Strike 3).
